

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

- All sessions must be pre-paid and booked prior to entering the ice. If sessions are not booked and paid prior skaters will not be allowed on the session. (details of this will follow in 'Whatsapp').
- Entry to the ice rink will be via the front door only, a one way system will be in operation
- Training gear, including skates must be worn before entering the building
- Skaters and anyone entering the building must register at the registration desk
- All people entering the building must use the hand sanitiser provided at the front door
- 2 metre social distancing must be observed at all times by parents
- Toilet facilities only to be used in a case of emergency
- Numbers on the ice will be regulated by us in accordance with BIS guidelines
- Social distancing markers will be placed on the barriers and each skater will be allocated their marker. This will be their designated area for water/rest etc.
- A register of all people entering the building will be kept to allow the 'Track and Trace' to be implemented should this be required!
- All surfaces must be deep cleaned after every skating session. This includes registration desk and all barriers within the ice rink
- Only one parent/guardian to be allowed in the rink at any one time
- Masks will require to be worn while in the premises by parents and coaching staff
- Skaters must wear masks to enter and leave the premises but masks can be removed and placed at designated area whilst skating. At the present we are unsure if skaters over the age of 12 years will be required to wear their masks on the ice. This will be clarified at a later date
- Everyone must sign out when leaving by the rear entrance leading to the car park
